**Minutes of the last meeting:**

**Matters arising:**

We have tried to contact Paul Rea but have not yet got a response.

East Midlands Cycle Forum meeting-no news.

Open Street Map for Chesterfield-still on track to finish at the end of the year-AM will find out where we are at with it.

**Membership report:**

309 members.

**Treasurer's report:**

£2166.29 at the end of February. Cost of items for sale and printing still to come out.

**Secretary's report:**

It has been reported that the cycle racks from the staff entrance at Tesco to the Locoford lane entrance.

We received large maps of the proposed a draft plan by Simon Tranter for a new cycle route from B & Q to town and from the town centre to the Railway station. Some of the paths are to be painted green. A few suggestions for improvements were suggested, AM to contact Simon Tranter about them.

We also received a copy of the draft plans submitted to CBC for the new “waterside development”. Simon Tranter met AM to discuss the plans. They have not yet been approved by highways officers from DCC. There should be a toucan crossing across Crow Lane and Brimington Road. AM will send a letter to the council with some of our comments. We want to retain the cycle paths along Brimington road. A new wider bridge should be put over the by-pass.

The plans for the cylinders site, at the back of the new housing estate on Derby Road, has no access from the cycle path to the new estate. Council have not done what they said they would do in planning. CCC will complain.

**Webmaster's report:**

**Items:**

Bike week has been changed to 19/06/10-25/06/10.

The TPT Baton Relay date remains unchanged.

The film festival will be on 19/06/10 in the afternoon.

Our stall in the market will be moved into the library.

Library is donating 3 rooms. Films-several shorts, in the lecture theatre. We will put cycle displays and our stall in the other 2 meeting rooms. Isabel Mulligan will put up a display about Polaris, the Dronfield based cycle clothing company. Michael Davie from the PCT wanted to emphasise sport rather than everyday cycling, he has agreed to give us £500 towards this event. Nicola Baker from the borough council is giving us £200.

**Family ride will change from 13/06/10 to 20/06/10 which is Father's day.**

**Pea and Pie supper is changing from 18/06/10 to 25/06/10.**

Items for sale:

We have agreed to buy 5 XL and 5 10-12yrs high visibility jackets-MC to order, 100 snap bands and 20 bells to sell on the stall-AM to order.

The baton relay to celebrate the 21<sup>st</sup> anniversary of the TPT is leaving Chesterfield on 17<sup>th</sup> June and is due to arrive in Barnsley Football ground on 19<sup>th</sup> June. The plan is for the baton to leave the town hall and go to the county border via the railway station. The mayor is now involved. CCC will get involved with possibly a mass ride to the town centre with the mayor.
